## Leave No Child Behind

**Text:** (Moses refusing to negotiate with Pharaoh concerning leaving children behind)

**ETS:** Moses was not willing to make the pilgrimage to the Promised Land without the children.

**ESS** (proposition): The Church must not make the spiritual journey without the children.

**Objective:** To remind/encourage the body of Christ why every effort to include the children in the journey is nonnegotiable.

## Reasons:

- I. First reason we should not leave our children behind is because they are our responsibility.
  - A. To abdicate our responsibility would give them over to influence of other "gods."
- II. Second reason we should not leave our children behind is because they are our treasure.
  - A. Heart of Israel Heart is where treasure is.
- III. Third reason we should not leave our children behind is because they are a needed source of <u>strength</u>.
  - A. Mouth of babes ordained strength/perfected praise
- IV. Fourth reason we should not leave our children behind is because they are our future
  - A. No one over 20 entered Canaan.
- V. Fifth reason we should not leave children behind is because they are the result/fulfillment of a promise.
  - A. Jochabed (Moses) Pharaoh desired to kill first born
  - B. Mary and Joseph (Jesus) Herod

The child you save could very likely be a promise in disguise.

Pharaoh was asking for:

- 1. forget responsibility
- 2. heart
- 3. strength
- 4. future
- 5. promise

You go on the journey but leave those things behind.

We must stop and ask ourselves who/what are we without

- 1. responsibility
- 2. heart
- 3. strength
- 4. future
- 5. promise
